1.	God's chosen king suffers unjustly, but he refuse	es to repay evil for
	evil, trusting God to vindicate him	(ch 24)

... Like Jesus Christ (but so much more!)

2. God's chosen king <u>suffers unjustly</u> AGAIN, but he STILL refuses to repay evil for evil, trusting God to vindicate him! (ch 26)

...Like Jesus Christ (but so much more!)

3. Enduring unjust treatment is very very hard, and but for the providential restraint of others, David would have blown it (ch 25)

...Unlike Jesus Christ (and so much more!)

What it means for us:

- 1. Appreciate our extraordinary suffering saviour-king (1 Peter 2:23)
- 2. Follow his example when unfairly treated today (1 Peter 2:21)
