## Near, Far, Wherever You Are, His Love Will Go On

Genesis 24

Intro: Genesis is suddenly a love story... ...with a big difference!

- 1. Trusting God's priorities even if it seems like a Mission Impossible (1-9)
  - Faith priorities:
    - a) Isaac must not marry Canaanites
    - b) Isaac must not leave the land
  - Practical Challenges: "And I would walk 500 miles..."
    - 1) 21 days journey (520 miles!) to find a distant relative
    - 2) Who is available to be married
    - 3) Who is a faithful believer in God
    - 4) Whose family are willing to say goodbye
    - 5) Who's willing to travel back without meeting her fiancé!!!
- 2. The key prayer: show your steadfast love to.... Abraham! (10-14)
- 3. God demonstrates that his <u>steadfast love to Abraham</u> does indeed continue... even in the next generation! (15-67)
  - Practical challenges amazingly overcome:

1)	Found!	15, 23-28
2)	Found!	16
3)	Found!	17-22

...wait for it... 29-49

4) Found! 50-51

...but wait for it 55-57

5) Found! 58-61

- God's promises amazingly reiterated: 60, cf. Genesis 22:17

So what are the implications for us?

- → Trust God's steadfast Abrahamic love goes on to future generations of the family: near, far, wherever you are.
- → So trust that God will fulfil his promises of permanent place & plentiful people, however challenging obstacles might seem.
